


Surviving Darwen Tram Rosettes

	Address	Current Owner/Tenant	Location
R1	47/49 Duckworth St	Olly's Kitchen/Booze Brothers	At gutter level between the two properties and possibly on a mounting plate
R2	141 Duckworth St	Former Brookside Hotel	Below the gutter at the LH end of the building
R3	210 Duckworth St	The Cock public house	At the RH end of the building at 2nd floor level. There are possible remains of rosette fixing holes at the RH end (1st floor level) of the former school opposite, now M&M Accessories
R4	6a Market St	Acklam Bond Solicitors	At the LH end of the property at 1st floor level
R5	3 The Circus	Former Nat West Bank	At the LH end of the property at 1st floor level and facing the main Post Office opposite
R6	3 The Circus	Former Nat West Bank	Facing the Millstone Hotel at the LH end in Church St at 1st floor level. Fixing holes to the left of a drainpipe can be seen opposite on the hotel
R7	Bank Chambers, Belgrave Sq.	The Retreat Hair Salon	On the side wall above the roof level of the adjacent RH property (2 The Circus)
R8	Bank Chambers, Belgrave Sq.	The Retreat Hair Salon	To the right of the main door at 1st floor level facing 1 Bolton Rd
R9	1 Bolton Rd	Candy Box Coffee	2nd floor level on Bolton Rd, facing the former bank building
R10	1 Bolton Rd	Candy Box Coffee	1st floor level on Bridge St, facing Millstone Hotel
R11	4 Bridge St	?Charity shop	At 1 st floor facing the Millstone Hotel. Fixing holes are also visible on the hotel opposite
R12	27-33 Bridge St	Bridge St Sports/Social Club	At 1 st floor level on the RH part of the building
R13	33-35 Bolton Rd	Pure Style Bathrooms	Below the gutter
R14	136 Bolton Rd	Kitchens Warehouse	At the centre of the frontage at 2nd floor level and facing the former Baptist chapel
R15	386 Bolton Rd	Darwen Furniture & Gifts (former Bowling Green Inn)	At the RH end of the building at 1st floor level

The above is a list of all the rosettes found between the boundary with Blackburn and Darwen Cemetery and have been numbered **R1** to **R15** from north to south. None have been found north of the tram depot in Lorne St, nor any beyond Bridge St on the Hoddlesden route. The ten surviving town centre rosettes are illustrated in the map.
